### **Other Pertinent information:**

1. Please do not wait until the last minute to get your gear. Begin getting it Thursday night and during the day Friday. Please be at the shop Friday night at the latest, to pick up gear no later than 5:00 pm.
2. Most of my class checkouts are held at the Mukilteo T-Docks. From 405 or I-5, take 405 S. Stay on 405 S towards the Mukilteo Ferry and it will become the Mukilteo Speedway. Follow the signs to the ferry. At the last stop sign (Ivar's across the street) take a right. The Silver Cloud Inn will be on the left and Parking will be on the N side of the Inn. Meet time is based on several variables and will be addressed prior to end of last class.
3. At times checkouts will be held at Alki. I will inform you if that will be the case (90% of the time it is not as parking is considerably more difficult)
4. Please try to be on time. It can be very complicated when students come straggling in.
5. Do your best to have your mask seasoned (toothpaste scrubbed). Your dives will be infinitely easier if your mask is not fogging up the whole time you are diving.
6. Tipping your dive masters is a nice gesture and appreciated but NOT required
